In celebration of Human Rights Day the Learning Network will be presenting a toolkit for training community members on the Right to health.

In South Africa, the Constitution protects people's social, economic and cultural rights, including their right to health. Yet the reality is that many South Africans do not access their rights to basic services and experience on going violations of their right to access to health care.

The toolkit was designed to help community organisations and social justice NGO's to identify and take action in response to violations of the Right to Health. It is based on the understanding that only by strong collective action can communities realise their rights, particularly the right to health.
